Question:	For the final inspection of an assembly, what is the scope of the visual examination performed as part of the final assessment?
Answer:	For equipment already placed on the market (including those falling under Article 4 §3 or excluded from the PED), the visual examination of an assembly carried out as part of the final assessment shall cover:
	 the identification of the equipment constituting the assembly, the joints between pressure equipment, at least one of which is category I to IV, the areas of the equipment that could have been altered since the placing on the market of these equipment (permanent joints, inappropriate storage, shocks, etc.).
	For category I to IV equipment which have not yet been placed on the market, they must also undergo a final visual examination as part of their conformity assessment.
	Note: The assessment of the integration of the assembly and its protection against exceeding the allowable limits shall also take into account the characteristics of equipment falling under Article 4 §3 or excluded from the PED.
